Flossie Thompson Dies This Morn

Mrs. Flossie Anderson Thompson, age, 50, widow of Charles O. Thompson, of Williamstown, Massachusetts, died at a local hospital this morning (Monday), following an illness of the last 6 months.

She was the daughter of C. Berton and Rebecca Centers Anderson, born August 18, 1910, at Livonia, Missouri. She received her education at Livonia, Missouri; Cincinnati, Iowa; and Grinnell. She was married to Elmer F. Moen, who passed away in 1954. To this union was born one son, Ronald, now of San Diego, California.

On February 8, 1935, she was united in marriage with Charles Oscar Thompson at Newton, Iowa. They had made their home at Newton; Chicago; Brockton, Massachusetts; Rochester, New Hampshire; and Williamstown, Massachusetts. Her husband, Charles preceded her in death just last December 30, 1960. Her father preceded her in death in December 1959.
