

MRS. JAMES THOMPSON DIES.

Passed Away Tuesday Evening—Bur-
ial in New Sharon Thursday.

Mrs. James Thompson passed away at her home in this city at 9:30 o'clock Tuesday evening following an illness of four weeks. She had suffered a paralytic stroke last April and had been in poor health ever since.

Funeral services were held at 2 o'clock from the home conducted by Rev. W. C. Wasser. The body was taken to New Sharon where short services were held at the grave. Interment was made in the New Sharon cemetery.

Sadie Wood was born Oct. 9, 1860, at Henry, Illinois, and died at Grinnell, July 24, 1923, aged 62 years, 9 months and 15 days.

She was united in marriage to James A. Thompson, Sept. 20, 1897.

She is survived by her husband and three brothers, E. P. Wood, of New Sharon, E. L. Wood of Montezuma, and John R. Wood, of Montezuma and one sister, Mrs. John E. Johnson, of Reinbeck. Two sisters preceded her in death.

She united with the Methodist church at Blue Point, in the year 1893.
