Edith Tiedemann, Former Resident, Dies Here Tuesday

Mrs. Lyle (Edith) Tiedemann, 61, of Ukiah, Calif., a former Grinnell resident, died at a hospital here Dec. 31st.

Funeral services will be held at 2 p.m. Friday from the First Lutheran church at Newton. Burial will be at a Newton cemetery.

Mrs. Tiedemann had returned from California to visit over the holidays and to have a medical checkup.

She was born Nov. 29th, 1902, in Richhill, Mo., and educated in the Novinger, Mo., area schools. She moved to Lenox, Iowa, in 1919 and to Newton in 1947. She resided in Grinnell for about three years before moving to California in March of 1963.
