

Rites held for Mrs. Tullis

Winifred B. Tullis, 85, of Oskaloosa, formerly of Grinnell, died Dec. 31 at University Hospitals in Iowa City.

Funeral services were conducted at the Garland Van Arkel Funeral chapel in Oskaloosa, with the Rev. Milo Morris officiating. Burial was in Forest Cemetery.

The daughter of William A. and Nellie Harlan Brady, she was born July 29, 1901, in Richland. She was married to Theodore Standing in 1926 at Berca, Ky. The couple had one daughter, Marianne.

In 1947 she was married to Guy L. Tullis of Oskaloosa at Knoxville.

Mrs. Tullis was a graduate of Oskaloosa High School and Penn College. She received her degree in library science from Louisiana State University.

She served as librarian at Grinnell Public Library and as a reference librarian at Grinnell College. She also served for five years at the McAllen, Texas, Public Library and for 11 years in the Oskaloosa Senior High School library. She had worked in the Oskaloosa Public Library many times.

She was a member of the United Methodist Church, Retired Teachers Association, Delta Kappa Gamma, Mahaska Historical Society, and Oskaloosa Women's Club. She served on the Oskaloosa Public Library Board for five years.

Survivors include her daughter, Marianne Woolfe of New Milford, Conn., and two grandchildren. She was preceded in death by her parents; her husband, Guy, in 1978; one brother, Clayton; and one sister, Grace Cassady.
