Louise F. Turner, 88, of Grinnell died Friday, April 7, at St. Francis Manor.

The body has been cremated. A memorial service was conducted Monday at the Smith Funeral Home, with the Rev. Bob Molsberry, pastor of the United Church of Christ — Congregational, officiating.

The daughter of John and Louise Simon Skvor, she was born April 18, 1909, in Cedar Rapids. She received her education in the Cedar Rapids School District and later attended Coe College.

She was married to Ernest C. Turner March 25, 1933, in Nashua. They continued living in Cedar Rapids where she worked for a pharmacy lab. They moved to Grinnell in the mid-1940s and owned and operated Turner Pharmacy on Fourth Ave. She worked as a bookkeeper and accountant for the pharmacy, retiring in 1962. They then lived in Cedar Rapids, Peoria, Ill., and Norway, Iowa, before returning to Grinnell in 1986.

Mrs. Turner had been a resident of St. Francis Manor since March of this year. She was a member of the American Legion Auxiliary.

Surviving are her husband; a son, John of Buffalo Grove, Ill., and a granddaughter. She was preceded in death by her parents; a brother, Leo Skvor; and a sister, Lenore Chehak.
