Mr. Van Egdom services held

Funeral services for Antonie (Tony) Van Egdom, 77, a former Montezuma-area farmer who died at his home in LeGrand Nov. 27, were held at 2 p.m. Thursday in Montezuma.

The Rev. William Kay Moser officiated. Burial was at the Jackson Township Cemetery.

The son of Antonie and Jeanette Van Manen Van Egdom, he was born March 7, 1901, in the Netherlands. He came to the U.S. when he was 9. As an adult he farmed in the Montezuma area until 1947,

then in the Tama area until 1973 when he moved to LeGrand.
