## Mr. Van Metre services held 1983

Earl T. Van Meire, 82, of Grinnell died Friday afternoon, Nov. 25, at the health care center of the Mayflower Home here.

Services were conducted Monday afternoon at the Clemons United Church of Christ at Clemons, Iowa, with the Rev. Philip J. Ramstad of the Grinnell United Church of Christ-Congregational officiating. Burial was at the Clemons Cemetery.
