

## Victor Rites For Henry Van Otegham

Henry Van Otegham of Victor, 82, who had farmed in the Brooklyn and Victor area for many years, died last Friday at the Marengo hospital following a month's illness.

Funeral services were held Monday at St. Bridget's church in Victor with the Rev. E.H. Hoening officiating at the requiem mass. Burial was in Calvary cemetery at Victor with Pete Van Hamme, Art Koehn, August DeMeulenaere, Wallace Edelen, John Geis and Felix DeCaluwe serving as pallbearers.

Mr. Van Otegham, who was born in Kapryke, Belgium Jan. 20, 1883, came to this country in 1905. He married Mary Stephanie Stevens in Brooklyn Jan. 7, 1909. After farming for many years the couple lived in Moline, Ill. for five years and moved to Victor in 1949.

He is survived by his widow, one son and six daughters.
