Mary C. Van Wyk, 52, of Sully, formerly of rural Grinnell, died of melanoma Saturday, Nov. 10, at Iowa Methodist Medical Center in Des Moines.

Funeral services were conducted Tuesday at the Sully Christian Reformed Church, with the Rev. Joseph I. Brinks officiating. Burial was in Sully Cemetery, with the Van Dyk-Duvin Funeral Home of Pella in charge of arrangements.

The daughter of Lambert and Wilma Dykstra Bouma, she was born April 8, 1938, in Hull, Iowa. She graduated from Western Christian High School there in 1955. She attended Dordt College in Sioux Center for one year.

After moving to Sully, she taught at Sully Christian Grade School for a year. She was married to Darrell Van Wyk May 29, 1957. The couple farmed in the Grinnell area until moving to near Sully in 1968.

Mrs. Van Wyk returned to college, graduating from Central College in Pella in 1972 with a degree in elementary education. She taught at Newton Christian Grade School for six years and at Pella Christian Grade School.
