

Clifford W. Van Wyngarden *BC June 24, 1988*

Funeral services were held Friday afternoon, June 19, at the Smith Funeral Home, for Clifford W. Van Wyngarden, 83, of Malcom, who died Tuesday, June 16, 1998, at Friendship Manor in Grinnell.

The Rev. Bruce Feuerbach, pastor of Calvary Baptist Church in Grinnell, officiated. Organist was Nancy Sears and vocalist was Mary Feuerbach. He was employed with Edwards Grocery and Mitchell Motors prior to working as a custodian in the Grinnell Newburg School District. He retired in 1979. The couple moved to Malcom in 1986. He was a member of Calvary Baptist Church.

He was preceded in death by a son, Larry Van Wyngarden, and a sister, Mildred Cline.
