Edna Mildred Cline, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. C. Cline, was born at Forrest, Illinois, May 7, 1889 and died at Oakdale, Iowa, May 12, 1927, aged 38 years and 5 days. She came to Iowa with her parents and lived in the Bethel neighborhood. Here she was converted as a girl and uniting with the Bethel Methodist church was an active worker in the Sunday School and church. On Jan. 7, 1913, she was united in marriage with W. S. VanWynyarden. To this union two children were born, Clifford and Mildred. She is survived by her parents, Mr. and Mrs. C. Cline, one sister, Mrs. Grace Hoover of Grinnell and two brothers, George and Harry of Lynville, Iowa. Mrs. VanWynyarden was never very rugged and following an attack of the Flu in October 1925 her health has steadily declined. Four weeks ago she went to Oakdale in the hope of being benefitted by treatment but it was of no avail. Funeral services were held at the home of her parents on Spring street on Sunday afternoon in charge of the Rev. George Blagg. Appropriate hymns were sung by Mrs. Carter and Mrs. Hutchinson, near neighbors and friends. Burial was made in Hazlewood.
