

## Fred Van Zuuk

Fred J. Van Zuuk, 90, of Grinnell died Friday, April 12, at Grinnell General Hospital.

Funeral services were conducted Monday at the Smith Funeral Home, with Del Coppinger of Oskaloosa and the Rev. Keith Briggs of Grinnell officiating.
