Guy G. Vander Pol, son of Gerrit and Minnie Elscott Vander Pol was born in Jasper county, near Lynnville, Iowa, on January 14, 1894. Following a prolonged illness he was taken in death on the morning of Sept. 20, 1960 in his home in Lynnville at the age of 66 years, 8 months, and 6 days.

On November 19, 1919 he was united in marriage with Maggie Eysink at Newton, Iowa. To this union two children were born, Delmer Vander Pol, now living near Lynnville, and Dorothy Vander Pol of Chicago.

Mr. and Mrs. Vander Pol spent the early years of their married life on a farm near Lynnville, moving to the town of Lynnville in 1943 where they lived together until Mr. Vander Pol's death. Surviving beside his wife and two children are two grandchildren, Marilyn and Peggy Vander Pol; a brother, Herman Vander Pol of Lynnville; and two stepbrothers, Jake and Albert Veldhuizen.
