Kellogg Services Held Tuesday For William Veber, 87

Services were held Tuesday at the First Christian church in Kellogg for William Veber, 87, who died Sunday at a Newton hospital.

A lifetime resident of the Kellogg area, Veber was born Nov. 7, 1872, at Kellogg, the son of Luther and Mary Veber. He was educated in the Jasper county schools and was engaged in farming until his retirement.

On Dec. 12, 1901, he was united in marriage with Tena Marie Paulson, who died in 1939.

Surviving are one daughter, Mrs. Martin (Ila) Wenndt of Lowden; two sons, Earl of Phoenix, Ariz., and Max of Kellogg; 13 grandchildren and four great grandchildren. He was preceded in death by his wife, two sons, one daughter, and one granddaughter.

Burial was in Our Silent City cemetery at Kellogg.
