

John Vieth Funeral Rites

Funeral services will be held this Friday at 1:30 p.m. at the Laurel Evangelical church for John H. Vieth, 80, who died Wednesday at a Grinnell hospital after a long illness.

Surviving are his wife Emma and three daughters: Mrs. Delbert Dowden of Conrad, Mrs. Vernon Sietmann of Laurel and Mrs. Frank Coppock of Gilman.

Also surviving are a nephew, Harold Wright of Laurel, who was raised in the Vieth home, five grandchildren, one brother, A. G. Vieth of Baxter; and five sisters: Mrs. Mattie Kahl of Albert Lea, Minn., Lydia and May Vieth of Turlock, Calif.; Mrs. Anna C. Wright of National City, Calif., and Mrs. F. C. Ramont of Denier, Calif. He was preceded in death by three brothers and a sister.

The son of Henry and Louise Wagner Vieth, John Vieth was born Nov. 24, 1877, in Jasper county. On March 10, 1907, he married Mayme Ramont. To this union three daughters were born—Verna, Leona and Wilma.

In 1913 the family moved to a farm southeast of Laurel where Mrs. Vieth died in 1921. On March 10, 1926, he married Emma C. Sietmann. They continued to live on the same farm until moving to their present home in Laurel upon his retirement in 1954.

Mr. Vieth was a charter member of the Marshall county Farm Bureau and also was a member of the Fairview Grange and the Evangelical church of Laurel.

The Rev. W. A. Spring, pastor of the Evangelical church, will officiate at the services. Burial will be in the Graceland cemetery near Laurel.
