Henry Sheldon Viets died on Dec.

1916. The Viets family emigrated from Europe to this country a few years before 1700 and in 1710 Dr. John Viets settled in Simsbury, Conn. He was the ancestor of the Viets families in America.

In 1860 Mr. Viets went to California by way of Panama. He taught school for a year at Stockton, Cal. In early Civil warfilmes Mr. Viets returned to Oberlin, and on Sept. 1, 1864, was enrolled in Company C, One Hundred Seventy sifth Ond Volunteer intantry. Sept. 23 he was made sergeant of his company. He was discharged from the

company. He was discharged from the army June 14, 1865.

Dec. 27, 1865, Mr. Viets was married at Kewaneagill, to Miss Louise Little. They resided a year in Oberlin and came to Grinnell, is included bring of 1867.
