## dies in crash

The Rev. Raymond George Vogel, 60, pastor of St. Patrick's Church of Marengo, died in an automobile accident Tuesday on Interstate 80 near the West Liberty interchange.

Funeral services will be conducted at 11 a.m. Friday at the Marengo church. The Rosary will be recited at 3, 7 and 8 p.m. Thursday, also at the church. Burial will be at 2:30 p.m. Friday at the Calvary Cemetery, Brooklyn.

The son of Nicholas and Elizabeth Vogel, he was born on a farm north of Malcom. He was a graduate of Malcom High School, St. Ambrose College and St. Paul Seminary at St. Paul, Minn. He was ordained in 1947.

Fr. Vogel served as an assistant pastor of St. Boniface at Clinton and at Holy Family Catholic Church at Davenport. He then became pastor of St. Michael's Catholic Church at Holbrook and St. Mary's Catholic Church at Keota before assuming the pastorate of St. Patrick's.

He is survived by his brothers, Victor Vogel of Brooklyn, Frank Vogel of Malcom, Charles Vogel of Grinnell, the Rev. Lawrence J. Vogel of Brooklyn and Louis H. Vogel of Riceville.
