Dick J. Vos, 92, of Sully died Wednesday, Dec. 20, at the Sully Retirement Home.

Funeral services were conducted Saturday at Sully Christian Reformed Church, with the Rev. Lawrence J. Howerzyl officiating. Organist was Darwin Van Wyk. Pallbearers were his grandchildren, Jim, Steve and Brad Vos, Carol Ver Ploeg, Stan Zylstra, and Phil and Keith Haan.

Burial was in Sully Cemetery, with the Van Dyk-Duven Funeral Home of Pella in charge of arrangements.

The son of Dick and Reintje Dekker Vos, he was born in Sprang, the Netherlands, April 28, 1903. He came to the U.S. when he was 7, and the family settled near Sully.

He was married to Minnie Roelofsen Jan. 6, 1926, in Sully. They farmed for 40 years in the Sully and Kellogg areas, moving to Sully in 1966. Following Mrs. Vos's death, he did carpentry work until retiring in 1988.

He had served on the Sully Christian Grade School Board and the town council. He had also been a member of the Sully Lions Club.

Surviving are four children, Evelyn Zylstra of Grand Rapids, Mich., Junior of Kellogg, Joey of Denver, Colo., and Arlene, also of Denver; 23 grandchildren; 40 great-grandchildren; and three great-great-grandchildren; and a brother, Cornie of Sully.

He was preceded in death by his wife, three children in infancy, one grandson, one great-granddaughter and two brothers, Joe and John.
