## Margaret Walker Services Friday

Mrs. Margaret Board Walker, 74, the wife of Glenn Walker of 603 Eighth Ave., Grinnell, died Tuesday morning at Grinnell General Hospital East. She had been in poor health the past few months.

Born Feb. 14, 1894, near Montezuma, she was the daughter of A. Sam and Elizabeth Grattan Board. She was one of ten children.
