Elven "Al" B. Wallace, 63, of 1115 Spencer St., died suddenly late Thursday at Grinnell General Hospital, following an apparent heart attack at his home.

The son of Benjamin and Ellen Swanson Wallace, he was born Dec. 16, 1910, at Fort Dodge, Iowa. When he was young, his family moved to Brainard, Minn., where he attended high school. On May 9, 1936, he was married to Violette Lundy at Webster City. The couple had two sons, Larry A. Wallace of Rock Rapids and Eugene D. Wallace of Colorado Springs, Colo.

Mr. and Mrs. Wallace moved to the west coast during World War II, and he was employed at the Navy Yard at Vancouver, Wash. Following the war, they returned to Iowa where they had made their home since 1950. Mr. Wallace had been employed by the Iowa Highway Commission since 1963.
