Former Grinnell Woman Is Victim of Accident Near Dexter; Funeral Held Here Today

Funeral services for Mrs. Tony Wallace, who was killed Friday evening in an accident near Dexter, Iowa, were held this afternoon in the Methodist church with Rev. H. S. Wilkinson in charge. The fatal accident happened about 9:00 o'clock, one half mile east of Dexter, and it appeared as if Mrs. Wallace had been struck by a car. The car apparently went on without reporting the accident, and fragments of glass near the scene gave the only trace of the car that was found.
