

## John Walstra

John L. Walstra, 67, of Port Washington, Wis., formerly of Grinnell, died Thursday, Oct. 21, in Milwaukee.

He attended school in DeMotte, Ind., and college at Central University, the University of Iowa, the University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee and Cardinal Stritch College, also in Milwaukee. He taught school in Grinnell for six years, then moved to Port Washington as physical education instructor and coach at Port Washington High School. He became athletic administrator, assistant principal and then principal in 1977. He retired in 1988.

He was a veteran of World War II and participated in the Battle of the Bulge. He was awarded the Bronze Star and then served with the 1st Cavalry in the Korean War.

He was a member of the National Association of American School Principals, the Association of Wisconsin School Administrators, past member of the American Legion, a charter member of the Lions Club and a member of the First Congregational Church.
