## 'Jake' Weber rites today

Jacob (Jake) Weber, 98, of Grinnell, recently of the Montezuma Senior Home, died Monday evening at Grinnell General Hospital. **OCT. 30**

Funeral services for Mr. Weber are scheduled for 1:30 p.m. today at the Smith Funeral Home on Broad St., with the Rev. Marcus E. Reitz, pastor of St. John's Lutheran Church, officiating. Organist will be Margaret Amo, and vocalist will be Ruth Ann Dayton. Pallbearers will be Ross Mintle, Grinnell Dunham, Lester Foster, Jim Foster, William Nagle and Clyde Austin. Burial will be at the Trinity Lutheran Cemetery near Malcom.

The son of Benhart and Sophia Lisker Weber, he was born May 4, 1880, in Malcom Township. He attended Grinnell schools. He farmed east of Grinnell until moving to an acreage on Penrose St. in 1928. For 45 years, he operated an antique business with his brother, Joe.

There are no survivors in the immediate family. Living in Grinnell, however, are a sister-in-law, Mrs. Fred Weber; two nieces, Gladys Weber and Mrs. Pearl Adkins; and a nephew, Paul Weber. Mr. Weber was preceded in death by three brothers, Fred, Joe and William Weber, and a sister, Mrs. Clara Diehm.
