Joe Weber, 88, of North Penrose Street, Grinnell died early Saturday morning (Aug. 21) at the Lone Elm Nursing Home where he has made his home the past four years.

The son of Benhardt and Sophia Augusta Liker Weber, Mr. Weber was born in Malcom Township, Poweshiek County, Iowa on June 6, 1882. He was baptized and confirmed at the Trinity Lutheran church by the Rev. John F. Reinck on March 29, 1896.

Mr. Weber was a member of St. John's Lutheran church in Grinnell. He had farmed most of his life and in 1930 moved to his acreage northeast of Grinnell.
