

## Arthur Wee services held

Arthur Wee, 83, of 105 Eighth Ave., Grinnell, died Wednesday afternoon, Nov. 13, at Grinnell General Hospital.

Funeral services were held at 1 p.m. Saturday at the Smith Funeral Home, with the Rev. Raymond Lott of the Grinnell United Methodist Church officiating. Organist was Kathleen Heffner, and pallbearers were Delmar Adkins, Keith Gregory, Robert Renaud, Kenneth Saunders, Clarence Scobee and Noel Taylor. Burial was in Resthaven Cemetery, West Des Moines.

The son of Lars J. and Barbara Moglestad Wee, he was born on Dec. 7, 1901, in Lake Mills. He attended school in Buffalo Center and Estherville.

On June 24, 1925, he was married to Grace Burrell in Estherville. They lived in Des Moines where he was manager of farm tire sales in eastern Iowa and Illinois for the Firestone Tire and Rubber Co.'s Des Moines district. In 1946, he opened the McKey and Wee Firestone Home and Auto Supply Store in Grinnell, later purchasing full interest in the business. He retired in 1970.

While in Grinnell, Mr. Wee was a member of the United Methodist Church and served as the church's Sunday School superintendent for several years. He was a member of the original Swimming Pool Commission which planned and built the municipal pool here. He was also active in softball organizations and helped design the diamond at Merrill Park. He was inducted into the local Softball Hall of Fame in 1976. He was also a member of the Grinnell Rotary Club.

Survivors include his wife, Grace; one son, Duane of Waterloo; four grandchildren; two great-grandchildren; and a brother, Oden Wee of Estherville. He was preceded in death by his parents and one daughter, Roberta Rae.
