Funeral Service

Luzetta Beatty Moore was born Oct. 5, 1876, in Montezuma, and passed away at Omaha, Nebr., Mar. 7 at the age of 84 years. She attended grade and high schools in Montezuma. In November 1900, she was united in marriage to Harry C. Wheeler of Grinnell. Shortly thereafter they moved to Pierre, S.D. and in 1909 they moved to Hinckley, Minn. where they resided until 1949 when they returned to Montezuma.

In October of 1959 they went to Omaha, Nebr. to make their home with their daughter and husband, Mr. and Mrs. Leo Goethe. Mr. Wheeler died at Omaha in January of 1960.

Mrs. Wheeler was a member of the Montezuma Methodist church and attended regularly until moving to Omaha.

She is survived by a son, Charles, Rankin, Ill.; two daughters, Mrs. Roberta Stalkankse, Kelly Lake, Minn., and Mrs. Marian Goethe, Omaha, a brother, Harold Moore, Montezuma; two grandsons, and one great grandson; other relatives and many friends.

Memorial services were held from the Steffy Funeral Home, Saturday, Mar. 11, at 2 p. m., conducted by the Rev. George S. Snyder of the Montezuma Methodist church. Organ music was provided by Louis Gorsuch. Casket bearers were Frank Wheeler, Allan Wheeler, Joe Alexander, Marcus Shearer, Dick Bernard, and Dick Bowers. Burial was in the Masonic I.O.O.F. Cemetery beside her husband.
