Donald Whisenand Rites In Illinois

Services were held June 22 at Farmington, Ill., for Donald L. Whisenand, 44, who lived on a farm just outside Farmington.

Mr. Whisenand died at 9:30 p.m. Tuesday, June 18 at St. Mary's Hospital, Rochester, Minn.
