Raymond White Services Held

Raymond White, 60, of 922 High St., died Monday evening at the Friendship Manor Nursing Home following an extended illness since April of 1963.

The son of Almon and Minnie Belle Kennedy White, Mr. White was born on Feb. 27, 1909, near Grinnell. He attended the rural school, Grant No. 4.
