Reva Marie White, 75, a native of the Sully area, died Wednesday at Iowa Lutheran Hospital in Des Moines.

Funeral services for Reva M. White were set for 2 p.m. Saturday, April 18, at the Lynnville Friends Church, with the Rev. Tom VanderWell, pastor of the church, officiating.

Burial was in the Friends Cemetery in Lynnville.
