Former Kellogg Minister Is Dead

According to The Red Oak, Iowa, Express, The Rev. Robert E. White, retired minister of the South Iowa Methodist Conference, died at Alhambra, Calif., Wednesday, December 13. Death was caused by leukemia and a stroke. He formerly served the Kellogg Methodist church several years ago.

Funeral services will be held at 1:30 p.m. Thursday, Dec. 21, at the Hamilton Funeral home, Des Moines. Officiating will be the Rev. George F. Dimmitt, Des Moines, manager of South Iowa Methodist Homes, Inc.

The Reverend White is survived by his wife, Nellie, and a daughter, Mrs. William T. Miller of Red Oak.

In 1958, the Reverend White retired from the Methodist ministry after 38 years of service, including 22 years in Iowa. He held Iowa pastorates at Kellogg, Prairie City, Epworth Methodist church of Des Moines, Corning and Corydon.
