Mr. Whitehill services held

George T. Whitehill, 48, of Marshalltown, a graduate of Grinnell College and a prominent athlete here, died Monday, Dec. 17, at his home.

Funeral services were conducted at 11 a.m. Monday at the First Congregational Church in Marshalltown, with burial at Riverside Cemetery.

He was born March 28, 1931, in Marshalltown, the son of W.N. and Adaline E. Thayer Whitehill. He was graduated from Marshalltown High School. While attending Grinnell College, he lettered in three sports.

Mr. Whitehill was president

of Marshall Office Supply, vice president of Ames Stationers, president of Equipment Services, Inc., secretary-treasurer of Marshall Printing Co., and one of the founders of Adventureland, Inc.
