

Mildred Wilcox Services Held

Mrs. Mildred E. Wilcox, 96, formerly of Malcom, died Tuesday morning at Skiff Memorial Hospital in Newton.

The daughter of Robert S. and Anna Lovin Snell, she was born Oct. 7, 1876, at Cherokee, Iowa. She attended Hillsdale College in Hillsdale, Mich., and was later graduated from Shenandoah Teachers College in 1898. She took advanced study at the University of Nebraska. Mrs. Wilcox was a teacher of mathematics and English in high schools in Nebraska and Iowa. She had been a resident of Newton since 1963.

On Oct. 28, 1908, she was married to Dr. Delano Wilcox at Ainsworth, Neb. She was a member of the Malcom Presbyterian Church.

Mrs. Wilcox is survived by a daughter, Phoebe Wilcox of Newton; and a sister-in-law, Mrs. Odessa Snell of Ainsworth, Neb. She was preceded in death by her husband in 1963, a son in infancy, two brothers, and two sisters.

Funeral services for Mrs. Wilcox were held at 2 p.m. Thursday at the Malcom Presbyterian Church, with the Rev. Floyd Conroy, pastor of the Knox Presbyterian Church of Cedar Rapids, officiating.

Burial was in Ivy Hill Cemetery, Malcom. The Toland-Wallace Funeral Home of Newton was in charge of arrangements.
