Janet Wilkins, 80, of Victor, died Monday, Nov. 17, 1986 at Mercy Hospital, Iowa city.

She was the daughter of T.J. and Mae Raffensperger Wilkins and was born Dec. 29, 1905 at Victor, Iowa. She attended school at Victor graduating in 1923, and attended C.C.C. Business School in Des Moines.
