Clark Woodrow Wilson,
80, formerly of Grinnell, died
Friday, Aug. 4, in Houston,
Texas.

A memorial service was
conducted Aug. 6 in Houston.
Memorials in his name may

The son of Frank Martin
and Lucy Clark Wilson, he
was born June 14, 1909, in
Lovilia. He moved to
Grinnell in 1922 and
graduated from Grinnell High
School.

He was married to Glendena
Florence Prusha Oct. 29,
1932. During World War II he
was a member of the 51st
Naval Construction Battalion
from 1942 to 1945, serving
in the Aleutian Islands, Ulithi
Islands, Saipan and the Mari-
anna Islands.

Mr. Wilson was a member
of the Elks Lodge in Grinnell.
He worked for Swift & Co.,
was owner and operator of the
"G" Recreation business, and
was a painting contractor be-
fore retiring. He last visited
Grinnell in June of this year.

He is survived by his wife;
