Donald Wilson dies in Darien

Grinnell College trustee, business executive and civic leader Donald L. Wilson died last week at his home in Darien, Conn.

A native of Red Oak and a 1925 graduate of Grinnell, Mr. Wilson received a master of business administration degree from Harvard University in 1928. A retired vice-president and director of Lionel D. Edie and Company, investment counselors and economic consultants, Mr. Wilson and his wife, Winifred Read Wilson, a 1927 graduate have given counsel and support to the college on a sustained basis. In honor of this long record of commitment and service, the Donald L. Wilson Lec-

tureship was established in 1981 to bring distinguished speakers to Grinnell for discussion of various aspects of American business.

Mr. Wilson had been a member of the Grinnell board of trustees since 1953 and was named a life trustee in 1979. He served on the finance and other committees of the board.
