Hazel M. Wilson Services Friday

Hazel M. Wilson, 56, of 1208 Summer St., Grinnell, passed away Tuesday morning at a local hospital.

The daughter of Paul R. and Minnie L. Detering Waltersdorf, she was born Dec. 11, 1911, at Creston, Iowa. She was baptized and confirmed at St. John's Evangelical church in Creston. She attended the schools in Creston and was a graduate of the high school there.

She later attended nursing school at the Evangelical Deaconess Hospital in Marshalltown, and for two years after graduation did general and private duty nursing at Community Hospital in Creston.

She came to Grinnell in 1936 and worked general duty for two

years at Community Hospital here.

On Oct. 20, 1938, she was united in marriage with Paul W. Wilson. To this union were born three children — Karyl Lee (deceased), and Paula Ann and Gary Dale, both at home. Her husband Paul preceded her in death in 1954. She was also preceded by her mother, a sister, and a brother.

Surviving, in addition to her two children, are her father; her brothers- and sisters-in-law, Mr. and Mrs. Dale Waltersdorf, Mr. and Mrs. Arthur Waltersdorf, Mr. and Mrs. Frank Waltersdorf (all of Creston), and Mr. and Mrs. Herbert Waltersdorf of Omaha, Neb. She is also survived by a number of nieces and nephews, great nieces and nephews, and aunts and uncles.

A member of the Methodist church and the Eastern Star, Mrs. Wilson also worked at the Mayflower infirmary the past four years. She was in charge of that unit.
