

Paul Wilson, Contractor, Dies Sunday

Paul W. Wilson, Grinnell contractor, died at his home early Sunday morning, Oct. 24, from a coronary attack. He was 40 years old.

Funeral services will be held Tuesday afternoon at 2 o'clock from James Funeral Home with Rev. John DeLong, pastor of the Grinnell Methodist church officiating. Burial will be at Hazelwood cemetery.

Born at Des Moines, Dec. 29, 1913, Mr. Wilson had resided most of his lifetime at Grinnell, where he graduated from high school.

He was associated in the contracting business with his father, L. O. Wilson, at Grinnell for many years.

Mr. Wilson was a member of the Methodist church, Masonic lodge, Eastern Star, and was a veteran of World War II. He served in the Navy.

He was married Oct. 20, 1938 to Hazel Waltersdorf at Creston.

Surviving are his wife, Hazel; a daughter, Paula Ann, a son, Gary Dale, and his father, L. O. Wilson, all of Grinnell. He was preceded in death by his mother, who died in April, and a daughter, Carol Lee, who died in 1942.
