The Brawley (California) News brings the sad intelligence of the death on April 24 of Helen Grace Fuller Wood. Mrs. Wood was born in Grinnell January 20, 1861, the daughter of Colonel and Mrs. S. K. Fuller. The family lived on the farm now occupied by G. A. Taylor. Colonel and Mrs. Fuller later moved to Early in Sac county and still later to California. Both are buried at Imperial, where Mrs. Wood was also buried.

Helen was married on April 20, 1881, to E. A. Wood. They moved to California at an early day and prospered. Mr. Wood owns a large ranch near Brawley but for the past year, on account of Mrs. Wood's failing health, they have been in Los Angeles.

Mrs. Wood was a sweet and noble woman and a telling force for good in the community in which she lived. She is survived by three brothers: E. M. Fuller, of Brawley, E. C. Fuller, of Imperial, California, and S. C. Fuller, of Iowa.
