

Kenneth Wood dies at 68

Kenneth J. Wood, 68, of 90 Fourth Ave. died late Tuesday at Grinnell General Hospital.

No services are scheduled. Following cremation, his ashes will be buried at Hazelwood Cemetery.

He was born Sept. 25, 1914, in Des Moines, the son of George and Belle Huff Wood. He attended Grinnell schools.

On Dec. 29, 1937, he was married to Elizabeth Jean Clifton in Grinnell. Mr. Wood was employed by the Morrison-Shults Glove Factory here.

He served with the U.S. Navy during World War II. Following his discharge he lived at Arlington, Va., where he was associated with the Washington-Maryland Transit Co. He later moved to Oswego, N.Y., where he farmed and worked as a purchasing agent for the firm of Stone and Webster, which manufactures electrical generating plants. While in Oswego, he was a member of the Elks Lodge.

The family moved to Grinnell in 1972.

Mr. Wood is survived by his wife Elizabeth. He was preceded in death by his parents and an infant son.
