

Services set for Mr. Wood

Raymond Everett Wood, 96, Rt. 4, died Tuesday morning Dec. 22, at Friendship Manor.

Funeral services will be held at 10:30 a.m. Monday, Dec. 28, at Smith Funeral Home with the Rev. John Epperson officiating. Burial will be at Hazelwood Cemetery. Pallbearers will be Fred Criswell, Kevin Criswell, Kirby Criswell, Larry Criswell, Eugene Lang and Ron Lang. A memorial fund has been established in his name with the recipient to be established at a later date.
