

Walter Wood 4-R 2/5/72 Services Held

Funeral services for Walter A. Wood, 55, who died Sunday, Feb. 5, at the Poweshiek County Home, were held Tuesday, Feb. 8, at the Steffy Funeral Home in Montezuma, with the Rev.
