

### MABEL WOODS

Mabel was born on March 20, 1909, at rural Victor, the daughter of August and Minnie (Fruendt) Smith. She attended rural country schools in Lincoln Township. She was united in marriage to Darrell Edward Woods on March 12, 1927. They lived on farms in Iowa County, and later moved to Millersburg.

Mabel was a member of Trinity Lutheran Church in Millersburg and was an active member of the Trinity Lutheran Ladies Aid. She has been a resident at the Williamsburg Care Center since July, 1985. She died May 29, 1986 at the age of 77.
