Harold E. Wunn, 79, of 308 N. Main St., Gilman, died of a heart attack Saturday, Oct. 15, at his home.

Funeral services will be conducted at 10:30 a.m. Tuesday at the Smith Funeral Home, with Dr. Harold Dellit of Fort Dodge officiating.
