

Mrs. Ethel Wylie Rites Held Feb. 6

Funeral services for Mrs. Ethel Wylie, 81, were conducted Wednesday, Feb. 6, at 12:00 noon at the Turner funeral home in Cedar Rapids with burial services at 2:00 p.m. at the I.O.O.F. cemetery in Brooklyn. The Rev. G.H. Hulsebus, pastor of First United Presbyterian church, officiated at the services.

Ethel Herma Jacobs, daughter of Thomas and Erma Jacobs, was born at Deep River August 3, 1881, and died in a Cedar Rapids hospital Feb. 3, 1963, following a long illness.

She grew up in the Deep River community where she attended the rural schools. On Nov. 23, 1903, she was married to Robert Wylie and four daughters were born to the couple. The family lived in the Deep River and Brooklyn communities. Mrs. Wylie went to Cedar Rapids 12 years ago to live with a daughter, Mrs. Ferne Myers. She was a member of the Presbyterian church of Brooklyn.

Surviving are three daughters: Mrs. Gene (Naomi) Rhinehart of Brooklyn, Mrs. Ferne Myers of Cedar Rapids and Thelma Wylie of Des Moines. She also leaves five grandchildren: 11 great-grandchildren and a brother, Earl Jacobs of Rockwell.
