

Marvel Young rites Friday ^{H-R}

Marvel G. Young, 49, of 334 East St., Grinnell, died early Wednesday morning, Oct. 30, following an accident west of Grinnell (picture on page 1).

The son of Gail and Elsie Pultz Young, he was born Feb. 9, 1924, at Marshalltown. When he was six months old, his parents moved to Grinnell, where he had lived since. He received his education in the Grinnell schools and was graduated from high school in 1942. He was baptized in the Lutheran faith at Marshalltown and confirmed at St. John's Lutheran Church in Grinnell.

For a number of years, Mr. Young worked for Swift and Company in Grinnell, and since Nov. 7, 1949, he had been employed by the Maytag Company as a machine operator. He was a member of

St. John's Lutheran Church and the Elks and Eagles clubs.

He is survived by his parents, and he was preceded in death by an infant brother, Glenn Duane.
