Fredrick W. Zimmermann, 77, of 509 Ninth Ave., Grinnell, died Wednesday, Sept. 18, at Grinnell General Hospital, following an extended illness.

The son of August and Caroline Gutmann. Zimmermann, he was born Jan. 31, 1897, at New Florence, Mo., and received his education in the schools of that community. He came to the Grinnell community as a young man and made his home with the Louis Englebart family.
