Mary Louise Zumwalt of 123 Fourth Avenue passed away on Wednesday afternoon, April 23, at a local hospital.

In later years, she was a member of St. John's Lutheran church.

at Newton, Iowa.

She had many accomplishments, principal of which was writing. For many years she was a faithful contributor of verse to the Grinnell papers, whereby she won many sincere and lasting friendships.

She leaves to mourn her passing her husband, J. E. Zumwalt, her daughter Elaine, and a host of friends and relatives on both sides of the ocean. She is also survived by a foster-sister, Mrs. Dudley Wolfe of Concord, Calif. She was preceded in death

by her parents.
